Engines

Rigorous testing of Dacia engines is carried out at our state-of-the-art test centres, with each variant undergoing 20,000 hours of running on the test bench and 800,000 kilometres of test driving.

The Dacia Sandero Stepway offers you two types of engine.

The TCe engine brings you more performance without excessive price. Thanks to turbocharging technology, the TCe 90 produces 90 hp from its 3-cylinder, 900cc engine, yet still achieves 55.4 mpg combined and CO₂ emissions of 115g/km*.

For those seeking ultimate fuel efficiency, the dCi 90 diesel engine achieves 74.3 mpg combined and only 98g/km CO₂*.
